ADMISSIONS POLICY for 2018-19 ENTRY

Admissions to Little Kingshill Combined School are determined by the local authority and all applications have to be made via them. For the Reception intake, they do take into consideration the distance from the school, if there are siblings already at the school and if the child has special educational needs.

We have an admission intake of 30 pupils for the Reception class in September each year. In extreme circumstances there is some flexibility in terms of children attending part time in the first half term. This is based on individual need and circumstance.

In Key Stage 1, we have an intake of 30 children into both Years 1 and 2.

In Key stage 2, we have an intake of 32 children into Years 3 to 6 inclusive.

In year admissions are also controlled by the local authority, but visits to the school to see our ethos in practice are encouraged and warmly welcomed.

All children in Reception to Year 2 are eligible for a hot meal at lunch time or they may bring a nutritious packed lunch instead.
