Christmas Fayre

We hope to see as many of you as possible at our Fayre tonight between 5.30 and 8.00pm. In order for the event to run smoothly and **safely**, can I please draw your attention to the following points:

- Please observe the speed limit of 30mph on Windsor Lane as you approach the school
- Please do not park on pavements as this impedes access for wheelchair users, pushchairs etc *and is illegal*
- Please do not park on the grass verges and embankments as these are easily damaged
- Please park to ensure that access to driveways and turnings are not impeded
- Please show consideration to the needs of pedestrians, residents and other drivers no matter how pressed for time you may be
- Please try to be patient and courteous, no matter how difficult the circumstances
- Needless to say, never park on the entrance driveway of the school nor illegally on yellow lines or junctions
- If at all possible, park a little further from school and walk the rest of the way
- Please do not park in the Village Hall Car Park as there is a music class booked in there.
