School Lottery & Art and Craft Supplies

FOLKS were recently made aware that, due to reduced government funding, there is a lack of money to buy art supplies for the children across the school. We have, therefore, donated £280 towards this. At the committee meeting on Wednesday, we have also agreed to donate all money raised by the school lottery this year towards art and craft supplies, so supplies don't run out again. The money raised from last month will go towards purchasing much-needed modelling clay for the children.
