Many of the children have now settled well into the Nursery and have already become familiar with the location of different resources and the typical daily routine.

Last week many of the children enjoyed having a go at our new balance bikes and we will continue to help develop their confidence on the bikes over the next few weeks. Last week the children also enjoyed taking part in a daily fitness session which included jumping, jogging and doing star jumps in a programme called 'Fitter Future' (which the main school is also following).

On Wednesday morning, we are planning to visit the Eco Garden in the main school. We will be encouraging the children to explore the different areas such as the pond, planting area and the bug hotel. We hope that the children will get some ideas on how we could create our own bug hotel back at Nursery.

Any resources that could help us create a bug hotel such as wooden pallets, bricks or bamboo canes would be gratefully received

On Thursday, the photographer will be coming to the main school to take individual photos of the children (and photos with siblings). This will be taking place at 10am in the main school. If your child does not normally attend Nursery on Thursdays, then come to the main school hall with your child at 10am on this day if you would like them to have their photograph taken.

We will be following the 'Jolly Phonics' programme this term, and will start with the letter 'S' this week. Each week, the children are more than welcome to bring items to the Nursery beginning with the 'sound (phoneme) of the week'. We discuss the letter sound rather than the letter name.

When possible we aim to include the children's ideas and interests when planning Nursery activities. Last week, we noticed that many children chose to play with and construct rockets. Therefore, this week we will be gathering more of their ideas about what they would like to do around a 'Space' theme. Please let us know if you have any resources or ideas that could help us with this idea!

Mrs Lindsay has very kindly agreed to be the Nursery 'class rep' for this academic year. We have placed a clip-board on the registration table so that new parents/guardians can add contact details.
