Dear Parents and carers,

I hope your children enjoyed their first week back.

I hope you are aware that the 'Meet the teacher' session is now on **Tuesday 18th Sept. at 8:45 p.m.** I am looking forward to seeing many of you then.

This week in year 3 we are covering:-

English:-

We are looking at how information texts are used in everyday life; exploring different kinds of texts. Grammar work will focus on imperative "bossy" verbs and past tenses for both regular and irregular common verbs.

They will also be sharing and writing book reports of a favourite book and comparing with non-fiction. Please help your child to choose and bring a favourite book for Thursday 13th.

The children will be practising their speech and presentation skills as they plan and present a simple speech for the school council and eco council elections. This will be part of the children's' homework this week.

Maths:-

This week we will complete the maths baseline work and begin the Year 3 curriculum.

The children will be learning to:-

- Count in ones, tens, hundreds and thousands; read and write the corresponding numbers and number words.
- Recognise concrete representations of numbers to 10 000
- Recognise that 10 hundreds = 1 thousand
- Translate numbers from
 - Models to words and figures
 - Figures to words
 - Words to figures

In addition to the tasks on the timetable there may be additional tasks on occasion.
