Dear Parents and carers,

This week in year 3 we will be covering to following:

English:-

This week the children will be writing their instruction pieces, focussing on a recipe format. We will be using the Roald Dahl inspired text 'Revoltng Recipes' as our starting point.

We are looking at how information texts are used in everyday life; exploring different kinds of texts. The childrens' homework will develop this. Please see their homework book for instructions.

Maths:-

This week we will be continuing our unit working with place value.

*The children will be learning to:*

- Identify the number which is 1/10/100/1000 more/less than a number
- Compare numbers and arrange them in ascending or descending order
- Compare numbers by place value to look for a pattern to complete a number series
- Read and write numerals in a place value chart given a set of concrete representations and vice versa.
- State the place and value of each digit in a number.
- Write 4-digit numbers as words.

Homework will continue to practise these aspects.

Mathletics:- The children have been given reminders of their logins (stuck in cover of their homework books) I have set some activities to support the work we are doing in class over the next three weeks. I would ask that they try the activities between now and October 5<sup>th</sup> when I will check progress and set new activities. If there are any issues with this please let me know in writing. It is possible to set simpler tasks or greater challenges if needed.

Homework:

The children did very well with their speeches last week. Thank you for your support in getting them organised! Please can you make sure the homework folders and books come into school every day, especially Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Rainforest trip

I hope to be organising a trip to the Living Rainforest for the class very soon, please look out for the specific information which will go out via Parentmail / school website.

### Music and sports
