Dear parents,

I hope you were not blown away by the wind last week and you were able to enjoy the weekend! Cold weather is approaching quickly. With the cold comes runny noses. Children are welcome to bring in pocket packs of tissues to place into their draws to use when needed.

Here are a few reminders for the week ahead:
