Dear Parents and Carers,

In **Maths** this week, we will be continuing to compare sets of objects and order and pattern of numbers and move onto making number bonds, recapping number bonds to 10 and 20 and using these to solve problems.

Key vocabulary that we will be using this week; less than, more than, compare, more, fewer, same as, greater than, smaller than, what is the same? what is different? pattern, order, next, 1 more than, total, part-part whole.

In **English** we will be focusing on the story of 'Handa's Surprise'. We will be thinking about animals that live in Kenya and their diets, retell the story in the form of a storyboard with captions and speech bubbles for each character / animal and making a list of vocabulary to describe the animals and / or fruit that appear in the story. We will also begin rehearsals for our Harvest Assembly, based on the story of Handa's Surprise. Children will be bringing scripts home to learn their lines.

In **Phonics**, we are continuing to learn Phase 5 sounds. Sounds that have been learnt previously will be continually recapped and we will begin to learn new sounds from phase 5. This week we are learning; oi, ir, ue and aw.
