## Week beginning 12<sup>th</sup> November

Thank you for your patience last week – the work on the new windows is now finished and so we will be back at the Nursery this week.

Last week the children enjoyed making Rangoli patterns with coloured rice, making firework pictures with glitter and printing poppies with bottle lids - it was certainly a creative week!

We will continue to think about robots this week and we will encourage the children to create more robots by junk modelling. We will focus on a story called 'Wendel's Workshop' where a mouse tries to invent a robot to tidy up.

Our mathematics activities will include encouraging the children to find and recognise numbers in their environment – hopefully they will spot some new numbers that have been set up somewhere at Nursery!

We will be setting up a fire station in the role play area outside.

We will continue to follow the 'Jolly Phonics' programme, and this week we will be focusing on the 'E' phoneme. Just a reminder that we focus on the sound the letter makes e.g. elephant, egg and Elmer (not eagle or eye).

This year our Nativity performance is called Humph the Camel and we will be performing it with the Reception class. We would like all of the Nursery children to be stars in the performance and it would be great if you could provide your child with either a white or yellow top (for us to put a star onto it) and a pair of light coloured trousers/leggings.
