Reminders

School Nurse: the school nurse will be visiting tomorrow to administer flu spray vaccinations.

Diwali Day: As a whole school we will be celebrating Diwali Day on Wednesday 7th November. Each class will complete several activities throughout the day including cooking, a dance workshop, listening to stories, learning how to put a sari on and many more. Children need to wear normal school uniform and have a pair of plimsolls to change into for the dance workshop. For the cooking workshop, all children will need to bring in a named apron. Thank you.

Nativity: We will be starting rehearsals for our nativity. We will be allocating parts and sending the script home by the end of the week so children can practise lines at home.

Maths: This week we will continue to use part-part-whole for addition within 10. We will move onto subtraction before the end of the week. Key vocabulary that we will be using this week; altogether, bond, pair, balance, addition, more, adding, greater, less than, subtract, take away.

English: We will be thinking about firework safety and writing acrostic poems based on a firework theme. We will also be writing our own versions of 'The Little Red Hen' using different characters and settings. We will be writing a section of the story each day and sharing our stories at the end of the week with other children.

Phonics: We will continue with Phase 5 sounds. This week children will be learning i making /ie/, o making /oe/ and zh (as in treasure).
