Dear Parents and carers,
This week in year 3:

English:

This week the children will continue sharing stories from other cultures. We shall be reading the story of 'The tiger child' and the story of Rama and Sita (linking with the whole school Diwali Day on Wednesday).

Maths:

This week we will continue learning to tell the time. The children will:

- state that 1 h = 60 mins
- convert hours to minutes (and combinations of both.)
- compare and order different durations of time.

If we have time this week, we may begin to familiarise the children with the 24 hour clock, recognising the a.m / p.m labels and converting from 12 hour times to 24 hour ones (and back). If not, work will continue on this next week.

Geography:

Learning about plants and sustainability of life in the Amazonian rainforest and thinking about the impact of deforestation on all kinds of life, and the effects, both local and global.

Homework- Our English homework this week will be linked to this topic.

Science:

This week the children will be learning that a balanced diet of different food groups is needed for health. They will create a 'food pyramid' to show the volume needed of each food group.

Homework:-

Spelling tests and the sending out of new spelling homework will take place on Thursday this week instead of Wednesday, due to the packed Diwali Day timetable!

Please note that the Mathletics homework tasks on Time which were set last Friday will have two weeks for completion (due 16th November). Please feel free to help your child if they need it and remember that they can do the games several times over if wished. Any tasks that are causing stress please leave or do together.
