Welcome back! We hope that you all enjoyed the Christmas holiday. This term we welcome five new children to the Nursery: Sophie, Freddie, Idrees, Heather and Yusuf.

Before the Christmas holiday, the children decided that they would like to play a shopping game, therefore we have created a supermarket in the role play area.

We will be listening to and completing activities associated with 'The Shopping Basket' story by John Burningham. Our mathematics activities will include counting the items that Steven (the main character in the book) needed to buy in the shop as well as counting items in our own shop. In the story, some items are taken away and so we will also be thinking about 'one more' and 'one less' when we are playing.

We will continue following the 'Jolly Phonics' programme, and this week we will be thinking about the 'G' phoneme. Each week, the children are more than welcome to bring items to the Nursery beginning with the 'phoneme of the week'. We think about the sound the letter makes (such as grapes, gorilla, or goose) and so not giraffe, gerbil, giant etc.
