## Week beginning 21<sup>st</sup> January

The children had a lot of fun painting and cutting out pictures of fruit last week. They also tasted 6 different fruit and had a chance to think which one was their favourite – pineapple was very popular!

This week our Mathematics activities will include comparing the weight of resources around the Nursery (using a balance). The children will practise using the terms 'heavy' and 'light' during their play.

We will continue following the 'Jolly Phonics' programme, and this week we will be thinking about the 'U' phoneme. Each week, the children are more than welcome to bring items to the Nursery beginning with the 'phoneme of the week'. We think about the sound the letter makes (such as umbrella, up or uncle) and so not unicorn!

As mentioned in the main school newsletter, the fundraiser lunches have been reinstated. We aim to include the Nursery in this event. Therefore, as a trial, the Nursery will be having their lunch in the DT room on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February. ### Helping your child at home
