Maths	This week the children will continue learning about division. They will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• use pattern with concrete representations to identify and name 'odd and even' numbers• use division by 2 to determine whether a number is even or odd• carry out the procedures in division starting from tens with regrouping, followed by ones• solve simple division word problems involving division of a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number with regrouping from tens to ones
English	This week we will be complete our work on non-chronological reports; the children will be creating a prospectus for both Hogwarts School and Little Kingshill. SPaG work will look at the prefixes auto-, anti- and super-. The children will be extending their understanding of conjunctions with independent work tasks.
