Week at a glance:

Maths	This week the children will begin learning about fractions . They will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• use the terms 'numerator' and 'denominator' to describe the parts of fractions• write a fraction given the numerator and the denominator• solve word problems relating to numerators and denominators• begin to understanding equivalent fractions• divide a fraction strip into equal parts to show a fraction• divide the divided fraction parts into further equal parts to show the equivalent fraction• write the equivalent fractions of a given fraction with denominator not greater than 12, with the help of model drawing
English	This week we will be looking at traditional poetry, including works by Robert Louis Stevenson. The children will look at the images it creates and write new verses of their own.
