YEAR 3 SUMMER TERM WEEK 1

Week at a glance:

Maths	<p>This week we will begin a new unit on angles. The children will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• identify what is an angle and what is not an angle• associate an angle with a certain amount of turning between two lines at a point• identify the bigger/biggest or smaller/smallest angle given two or more angles• arrange angles in ascending or descending order identify and mark angles on geometrical shapes• associate the number of sides with the number of angles in geometrical shapes <p>For homework, please continue to practice times tables (and related division facts at higher levels) as we will resume times tables challenges next week.</p>
English	<p>This week the children will be planning questions and writing reports about the farm trip. They will be competing reading and comprehension activities. SPaG work and spellings will begin again next week.</p> <p>Homework this week will be to complete a Roman Gods fact poster. We have begun these in class. The children may use the internet or non-fiction sources to find facts about their chosen god, and illustrate a picture of them. It will be due in next Monday (not Friday due to the short week)</p>
