Week at a glance:

Maths	<p>This week we will begin to work on area and perimeter of shapes. They will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• understand that the area of a shape is the amount of surface covering it• understand that a square or a half-square is used as a standard unit for representing area• find the area of a shape, made by squares and half-squares, in terms of square units• make different shapes of the same area with the same number of square units
English	<p>This week the children will continue their work with the story of The Hodgeheg by Dick King-Smith.</p> <p>This week they complete their plans for their own adventure quest stories, and then begin writing them. They will produce their work in small books.</p> <p>The children will write plans for a short animation sequence.</p> <p><i>English homework this week is to continue working on their Geography project, creating a short information leaflet about a European country of their choice.</i></p>
